PREBLE DISTRICT OUTSTANDING CUB SCOUT

The Preble District community has established an outstanding Scout award. This award is to be presented at the District appreciation dinner that is held each February. This award consists of a distinctive patch developed expressly for this award.

The award can be conferred on an individual only once. This is interpreted to mean that the individual could have an outstanding Scout as a Cub Scout; an outstanding Scout as a Boy Scout; and an outstanding Scout as an Explorer.

The award can only be worn as a temporary patch until the next year's presentation.

Each Pack in the Preble District may submit one Scout they consider their outstanding Cub Scout. The Scout selected must meet the following minimum requirements:

1. The Scout must be registered in an active Pack.
2. The Scout must have completed three achievements in the last six months.
3. The Scout must write an essay of 50 words or more about "What Scouting Means to Me".
4. The Scout must demonstrate he is an outstanding Cub Scout by attendance at Den and Pack meetings faithfully.
5. The Cubmaster must submit a signed statement asserting that the Cub Scout has met the above requirements. This statement, along with the \$1.00 (one dollar) fee, must be submitted no later than the February Roundtable.
